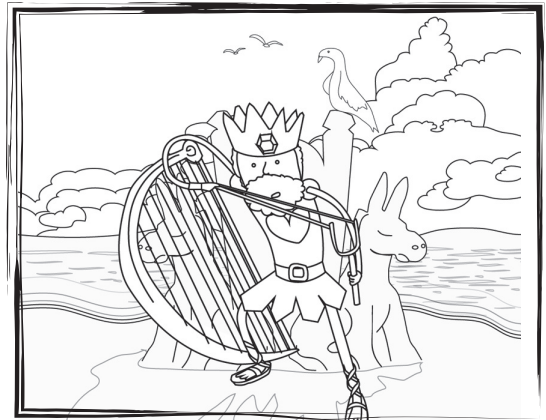


2 Samuel



Now there are two “sand mules” on the beach because this is the book of 2 Samuel. In the picture is a king—**David**—with a harp, a slingshot, and a whole heart for God. The life story of King David—whom God called “a man after My own heart” (Acts 13:22)—unfolds



in 2 Samuel. After Saul’s death, David rules first over Judah, then over a united Israel, for a total of 40 years. He follows God with a whole heart and becomes Israel’s greatest king. David’s political and military victories bring Israel to a place of world prominence. But the secret sins of his personal life ultimately cause his downfall. A lustful look at beautiful Bathsheba leads to adultery and murder, then to insurrection, civil war, and unrest.
