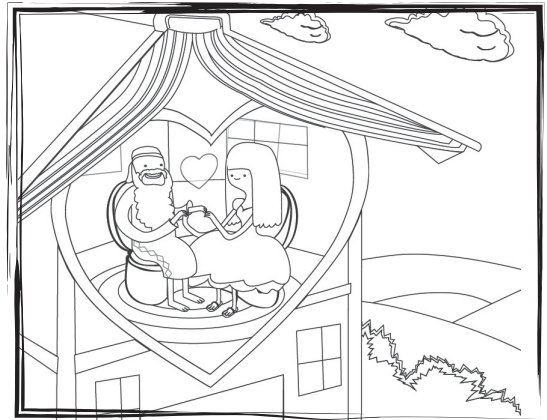


Ruth

See the book on top of the house? It's a romance book, but it's also the roof of the house. So this is the book of "Roof," or Ruth. Against the dark backdrop of the time of the Judges in Israel—filled with human rebellion and divine judgment—Ruth is a **love story** of devotion and redemption.



A young widow who leaves her family and her native land of Moab to help the mother-in-law she loves, Ruth gleanes in the fields belonging to a relative, Boaz, who grows to love her. Because of Ruth's faithfulness in a time of national unfaithfulness, God rewards her with a new husband (Boaz), a son (Obed), and a privileged position in the lineage of Christ (she is the great-grandmother of David). By marrying the widow and redeeming the family's property, Boaz is a picture of Christ as the "kinsman-redeemer."
